
#### **Conclusion: -**


- 1. 16.8% strongly agreed and 76.9% agreed when asked about the satisfaction regarding the present syllabus making 3.1% disagreed and 3.1% gave no opinion.
- 2. Do you expect changes in the syllabus was another essential question? To this, 7.8% strongly agreed, 41.6% agreed, 25.9% disagreed and 24.6% gave no opinion.
- 3. When asked about the syllabus is upto the mark, the students' replied with 12.7% strong agreement and 63% normally agreed. However, 5.8% disagreed and 18.5% students gave no opinion.
- 4. 24.2% strongly agreed and 69.1% normally agreed when asked about their satisfaction regarding the selected course/subject. While, 1.4% disagreed and 5.3% students gave no opinion about the same.
- 5. Do you get practical knowledge from the present syllabus? To this question, students responded with strong agreement of 15.9% and 65.9% normally agreed. Additionally, 7.8% disagreed and 10.4% gave no opinion.


As per the above data given by the students, 15.48% of the total students strongly agreed with the questions asked related to subject, its syllabus, design, the corresponding review and its relevancy. A total of 63.3% students' strength responded with normal agreement while 8.8% disagreed and raised some concerns. However, 12.42% of the students' count provided no valuable opinions.




#### **Conclusion: -**


- 1. 35.7% of the teachers are strongly agreed and 53.6% are agreed the learning objectives are clear appropriate to the need of students. Only 7.1% teachers are disagreeing while 3.6% gave no opinion.
- 2. The syllabus is well organized and easy to follow, it is strongly agreed by 28.6% and agreed by 60.7% of the teacher. It means 100% teachers are agreed the syllabus is well organized and easy to follow. Only 10.7% teachers disagreed.
- 3. The depth of the course content is adequate to have significant learning outcomes for which 35.7% strongly agreed, 60.7% normally agreed and 3.6% disagreed.
- 4. The study materials are easily available. It is strongly agreed by 32.1% and agreed by 64.3% by the teachers. Only 3.6% teachers are disagreeing.
- 5. 25% teachers are strongly and 64.3% teachers agreed the syllabus is job oriented, but 10.7% of the teachers are disagreeing.
- 6. 39.3% teachers strongly agreed and 57.1% teachers normally agreed when asked about the syllabus/course helped them increase their knowledge and perspective about the subject area. However, 3.6% gave no opinion.




#### **Conclusion: -**


- 1. 25% strongly agreed and 70% agreed when asked about the satisfaction regarding the present syllabus for value-based making 1.7% disagreed and 3.3% gave no opinion.
- 2. Is the curriculum suitable for employability was another essential question? To this, 15% strongly agreed, 76.7% agreed, 3.3% disagreed and 5% gave no opinion.
- 3. When asked about the syllabus is suitable for overall development, the alumnae replied with 15% strong agreement and 75% normally agreed. However, 5% disagreed and 5% alumnae gave no opinion.
- 4. 15% strongly agreed and 73.3% normally agreed when asked about their satisfaction regarding the curriculum's projection for global competence of students. While, 5% disagreed and 6.7% alumnae gave no opinion about the same.
- 5. Are you satisfied with faculty initiatives? To this question, alumnae responded with strong agreement of 20% and 66.7% normally agreed. Additionally, 5% disagreed and 8.3% gave no opinion.


