- Jonathan Swift was born on 30th November 1667 in Dublin, Ireland
- Father's name - Jonathan Swift
Mother's name - Abigail Erick
- Enrolled at Kilkenny School in 1674
- Admitted in Trinity College, Dublin in 1682
- Received Bachelor's Degree in 1686
- Received Master's Degree in 1692
- Jonathan Swift died on 19th October 1745



SATIRE

Satire is a technique employed by writers to expose and criticize foolishness and corruption of an individual or a society by using humour, exaggeration, irony or ridicule. It intends to improve humanity by criticizing its follies. A writer in a satire uses fictional characters which stand for real people to expose and condemn their corruption.

Example : Cartoons in newspapers, magazines, whatsapp, facebook and many more.

STRESS and STRAIN



- Traditionally, pressure or tension exerted on an object is called as stress but in biological terms, it does not have a pre-defined definition.
- It can be understood as “any external factor that negatively influences plant **growth**, productivity, reproductive capacity or survival.”
- It is of two types: **Biotic and Abiotic Stress**.

The **abiotic stress** is influenced by **non-living characteristics of the environment** and causes the loss of major crop plants worldwide. Abiotic stresses such as drought (water stress), excessive watering (water logging), extreme temperatures (cold, frost and heat), salinity and mineral toxicity, **negatively impact** growth, development, yield and seed quality of crop and other plants.

Biotic stress in plants is caused by living organisms, specially viruses, bacteria, fungi, nematodes, insects, arachnids and weeds. The agents causing biotic stress directly deprive their host of its nutrients can lead to death of plants. **Biotic stress** can become major issue because of pre- and postharvest losses. The defense mechanisms which act against **these stresses** are controlled genetically by plant's genetic code stored in them.
