A meeting of the IQAC with staff members was held on 15th September 2021, to assess the execution of proposed action plan for the session 2021-2022

- Enhancing research through the College Research Promotion Committee: The Research Promotion Committee not only has this Cell hosted several webinars on research opportunities, research proposals, academic writing, and publication ethics, but it is also encouraging the faculty member for preparing a proposal for a minor research project to support them in pursuing their research interests.
- **Student Progression**: Efforts are made to encourage advanced students to participate in not only research but also to develop an academic writing habit. Student progression list have also been prepared to identify the departments in which previous batches of students have either taken admissions or accepted job opportunities.
- Remedial Classes: Study teaching and monitoring committee of our college has rethought
 the practice of offering remedial classes to students. The Cell will organize student
 capacity-building programmes and teacher-led remedial sessions in order to improve their
 academic competitiveness.
- Alumni Network: The Alumni Relations Cell has created a platform for alumni to connect through WhatsApp groups and offer career advice as well as discuss current research interests.
- **Best practice:** Efforts are made on a regular basis to maintain the best environmental sustainability and community outreach practices. A green audit is being carried out; medicinal garden has been set up by the Botany Department; waste management mechanism is in place to contribute towards environmental conservation.
- Career Placement Cell: Through this cell, Career Enhancement Programmes will be organized.
- Increasing collaboration: The departments have been encouraged to linkage/collaborate with other institutes. The Botany department of our college has signed MoUs with the Shri Shivaji Science College, Amravati in September 2021.
