### Coexisting with COVID-19: Experts say safety is defence

RAIPUR, May 15

THE Internal Evaluation Quality Cell of Government Arts and Commerce Girls College, Devendra Nagar, Raipur organising a webinar on 'CoexistingWith-COVID-19' on Saturday. Doctors from different departments shared valuable tips on how people can be safe in this corona crisis.

Dr Siddharth Patanwar, Chest Physician of VY Hospital said that safety is the defence. He said that the general public should wear a mask with a two-layer cotton cloth, which covers the nose and mouth well, with no gap anywhere. The cloth of the mask should not be hard. The general public should not wear a mask with an axle valve. N95 masks should also be worn only by doctors and health care workers. Dr Patanwar explained the correct use of RTPCR, CT scan, pulse oximeter.

Dr Patanwar said that it is not necessary to have a CT scan of every corona patient. He said that Remdesivir injection is not a miracle drug for corona. It should be used

only on medical advice. He gave detailed information about plasma therapy and who can donate plasma.

Dr Patanwar said that vaccination is absolutely safe and all should get it. Whatever vaccine is available, you can get it, he said. The second dose should be applied between 6 and 8 weeks after the first dose of the vaccine. If anyone is infected by corona even after the second dose of the vaccine, then its severity is very less. After vaccination, human body takes two to three weeks to form antibodies. It is common to have slight fever pain or joint pain after the vaccine.

Dr Ranjana Tiwari, who was infected by COVID and got cured, narrated her experiences and said that it is affecting human beings but not humanity.

Dr Ravi Sharma proposed a vote of thanks at the end of the programme. The programme was attended by Dr Sandhya Verma, Dr Sheela Dubey. Dr Meena Pathak, Dr Preeti Pandey. Dr Sushma Tiwari, Dr Madhuri Shrivastava, Dr Anjana Purohit along with senior professors Dr M PThakur, Dr Renu Maheshwari and Dr Sunita Patra.

Earlier, College Principal Dr Amitabh. Banerjee conducted the webinar and Internal Evaluation Quality Cell In-charge Dr Kavita Sharma. Usha Agrawal delivered welcome address in the webinar while Dr Ravi Sharma sang a prayer. Dr Lakshmi Devnani introduced the keynote speaker.
